

Davidson PD Comparative Data for 2019-2020

The Uniform Crime Report (UCR) is collected data from all law enforcement agencies by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). The data is separated into three categories of Part 1 Offenses, Part 2 Offenses and what is termed Non-Criminal Offenses.

Law enforcement agencies report the number of offenses and associated crime data for the following:

Part 1 Offenses: Murder, Negligent Manslaughter, Forcible Rape, Robbery, Aggravated Assault, Breaking and Entering, Larceny, Motor Vehicle Theft, Shoplifting, all types of Theft and Arson. Part 1 offenses, excluding Negligent Manslaughter and Arson, are used to calculate the Crime Index and Crime Rate.

Part 2 Offenses: Arrest data only on Assaults, Forgery, Swindle, Credit Card/Teller Fraud, Embezzlement, Fraud, Impersonation, Bomb Threat, Kidnapping, Prostitution, Pornography, Sex Crimes*, Crimes Against Family/Child, Drug Offenses, Gambling, DWI, Trespass, and Hit and Run.

Non-Criminal Offenses: Missing Person, Suicide, Sudden Death, Overdose, Vehicle Recovery, Fire and other non-criminal incidents.

Davidson Police reported an overall increase in both UCR reported categories from 2019 to 2020:

- Part 1 Crimes had a 2.27% increase overall.
- Part 2 Crimes had a 21.62% increase overall.
- Non-criminal Offenses increased by 6.8%.

Significant increases in calls for service, not reported under UCR requirements, include:

- Animal Attack and Bite – 58%
- Disturbances – 71%
- Domestic Disturbances – 49%
- Commercial and Residential Alarms – 75%

Davidson Police reported decreases or a level number of reported crimes in the areas of:

- Robbery
- Aggravated Assaults
- Larceny from Auto
- Theft from Building
- Indecent Exposure
- Breaking & Entering
- Drug Offenses
- Hit & Run

*Sex offenses include: Statutory Rape, Statutory Sexual Offense w/a Child, Sexual Activity by Parent, Sexual Activity w/a Student, Sexual Contact under Pretext of Medical Treatment, and Sexual Battery.
