II. New Business

a. **Immediate Priorities/VZTF Focus**

Doug Wright gave an update on the Pedestrian Safety Task Force recommendations. He discussed items that were completed and items that were being worked on, along with an update on a few of the other items. The VZTF talked about ways to communicate the progress and mechanisms for continuous feeds of current information to keep the community updated. Ways to communicate progress included regular reports to the Board of Commissioners, information in the Town Newsletters, a progress update webpage, and some printed materials. Education was a main priority discussed and that it is key to create culture change in the town. The Davidson Police Department has applied for a grant that would allow for the hiring of an education officer who will help in the VZ effort.

b. **Communication with Board**

The VZTF will get on the rotation of advisory boards to give a quarterly update to the Board of Commissioners.

III. Old Business

a. **VZ Plan**

Members of the VZTF and staff discussed pros and cons of going forward with a VZ Plan. Staff discussed the steps needed to take for a VZ Plan and stated the VZ TF would be an instrumental part in the whole consultant selection process from drafting the RFP (Request for Proposal) to make sure it represents Davidson and our needs to reviewing, scoring, and choosing the consultant.

b. **Town Day/Bike Expo Programming**

The VZTF discussed the dates of Town Day (May 7) and the Bike Expo (May 14) and brief ways they could be involved. Leslie Willis is going to work with Laura Schumacher to create some handouts/stickers/decals as a way to start marketing and branding Davidson's commitment to Vision Zero. More details on the upcoming events and the VZTF involvement will be worked out post meeting.
