to A Nonprofit Organization N.C.G.S. §160A-280


The Town of Davidson, North Carolina is providing public notice to declare surplus office furniture and authorizing donation to the Salvation Army. N.C.G.S. §160A-280 allows the Town of Davidson to donate to another governmental unit within the United States, or a nonprofit organization incorporated after advertising and Board approval.

The Town of Davidson owns the following office furniture:

- (11) 4 Drawer File Cabinets
- (4) Benches - 6'
- (7) 2-Drawer File Cabinets
- (2) Book Shelves
- (10) Chairs with Arms - Teal
- (1) Large Round Table with collapsible legs
- (9) Chair-Rolling Conference Table – Leather
- (1) Small Round Table with 2 chairs
- (2) Barrel Chair – Wood
- (1) Chair - high back padded – garnet
- (1) 6' Wooden Desk
- (2) Wall Clock; and
