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Passive Recreational Use - Survey Data

I. General Uses of the Property - Passive Recreation w/ respect to other options

- While not a strong 1st choice (14.67%), 2/3 of respondents (66.8%) ranked as 2nd or 3rd choice.
- Less than 10% ranked it as their fifth and sixth choice, making it the choice with the least objections.
- Overall, it was ranked third with an average score of 4.42 behind Natural Use (4.51) and Active Recreation (4.49).

II. Preferred Passive Recreation Uses of the Property

- Strong support for gathering structures such as a stage or amphitheater, covered outdoor shelter space or pavilion.
- Other passive uses with support included hiking trails in the natural area, picnic tables, community garden and a playground, among many ideas submitted for this category.
- 350 comments (24% of the total comments) submitted in the survey appear to indicate a preference for passive recreation, consistent with 24% of survey responses in support of Passive Recreation as the primary use.

III. Conclusion:

There was support for scattering passive recreation options throughout the site, as secondary use, rather than concentrating it in all or one specific area.

Passive Recreational Use - Public Input Sessions

Summary of Public Input Sessions

- Passive recreation received 79 green dots (13.7%) of the total 576, ranking it third behind Natural Areas (59%) and Affordable Housing (16.5%).
- Within Passive Recreation, small parks space had the highest number of green dots with 33 (42%) of the 79 representing that option.
- Natural Areas had an additional 18 green dots indicating a preference for small parks space.
- Overall, there was consistent preference for small parks space except in the third public input session at Ada Jenkins which favored a community garden (62%) with small parks space rated second (19%).

Conclusion

- Passive Recreation options have strong support based on the survey feedback and public input sessions
- It could easily be combined with another primary use(s) to serve the most citizens in the community.
- The survey data and public input session data for passive recreation was found to be consistent with strong support for passive recreation especially if combined with either active recreation or natural area options.
